### Inspection Updates:

### Vehicle Inspection Report (VIR) and Sticker Expiration

#### Go green - Go online!

Effective October 1, 2022

- Customers **will not** receive a printed vehicle inspection report from the inspection station for a **passing inspection**
- To access and print a report, customers can go to [mavehiclecheck.com](https://mavehiclecheck.com) or place a phone camera over the QR code below



- Have your license plate number and vehicle identification number (VIN) ready, all information can be found on your vehicle registration document.
- Customers **will** receive a vehicle inspection report for a **failed inspection**

#### Don't be late - Check your date!

Effective November 1, 2022

- If you are **late** with getting your vehicle inspected:
  - Your new sticker will have the number of the month your inspection was **originally due**; **not** the number of the month your vehicle is now being inspected
- If your inspection sticker **expired last year**:
  - Your vehicle will receive a January sticker (1) of the **current year** your vehicle is being inspected; no matter the month your vehicle is inspected this year
