Vans/trucks and trailers require Commercial safety inspections when:


- Trailer has a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) over 3,000 pounds; or
- Gross combination weight rating (GCVWR) of the van/truck and trailer is over 10,000 pounds
